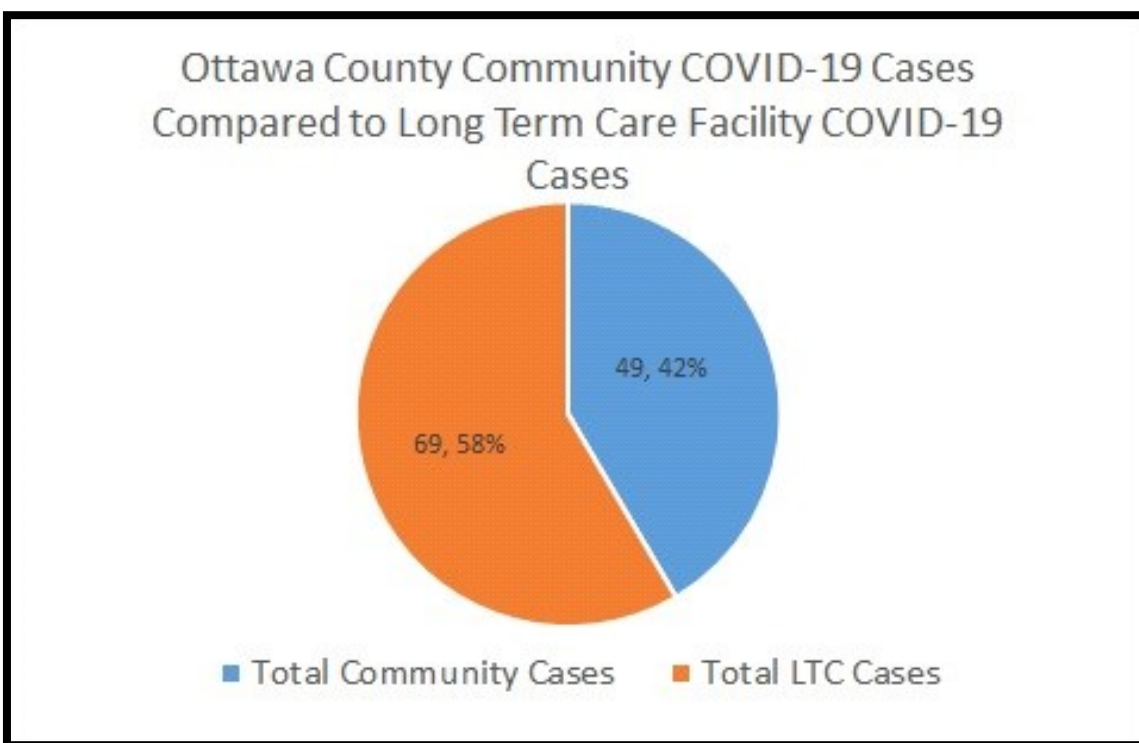


COVID-19 Statistics & Recovery

Here is an updated look at the statistics for COVID-19 for Ottawa County. We currently have 118 total cases, 115 of those being laboratory confirmed cases, 3 are probable. Ottawa County currently makes up just 0.27% of all cases in Ohio. We currently have 22 deaths in our county making up 0.83% of all deaths due to COVID 19 in Ohio.

In Ohio, it still appears that 94% of confirmed COVID-19 patients have recovered or are recovering. 84% of people are managing their symptoms without hospitalization indicating they have mild to moderate symptoms. We can also see that only 4% of diagnosed people are requiring an ICU admission.

The hospitalization rates and ICU admission rates have continued to decrease since we first reported these statistics.



This chart compares long term care facility (LTC) spread vs community spread of COVID 19 using our current case count. As you can see, 58% (69 cases) of our total cases are from outbreaks at long term care facilities within Ottawa County. 42% (49 cases) of the cases are from people within the community. 39 of these 49 are true community spread cases meaning the case has no known link to confirmed/ probable case, 10 cases are positive contacts to one of the 39 cases. It is possible to have multiple cases linked to 1 person, or 1 household could have multiple positive cases. We highly recommend wearing facial coverings when in public, washing your hands frequently, and limiting social gatherings to help decrease the spread of COVID 19 within our community.
