## Recent Ohio Department of Health Orders

- 12/24/20 – On 12/22/20 the Ottawa County Health Department received its first shipment of the Moderna vaccine and on 12/24/20 the Ottawa County Health Department started to administer doses of the vaccine to first responders. All vaccine dispensing will be subject to availability of doses and approval and will be distributed according to state and federal guidelines.
- 12/10/20 – Governor DeWine extended the Statewide Curfew, which is now in effect until January 2, 2021. This curfew is from 10pm to 5am.

## Ottawa County Health Department Activities

- Currently we have **19** people in isolation and **65** people under quarantine in the Ottawa County School System. These numbers have been communicated to the schools and reflected on their individual dashboards. We are actively monitoring the cases in the schools with the districts and communicating weekly with the school superintendents.
- Ottawa County stayed at risk **level 3 (Red)** in the Public Health Advisory System this week. Ottawa County meets **4** out of the 7 indicators that influence risk category. Risk level 1 (**yellow**) means a county meets 0-1 indicators, risk level 2 (**Orange**) means the county meets 2-3, risk level 3 (**Red**) means the county meets 4-5 indicators, and risk level 4 (**Purple**) means the county meets 6-7 indicators.
