### PRESS RELEASE

#### *Important Changes to the Governor's Stay-at-Home Orders*

- *Anyone entering Ohio with the intent to stay is asked to self-quarantine for 14 days. There are exceptions for those who work over state lines.*
- *Campgrounds, public or private, shall be closed with the exception where a camper or recreational vehicle in a campground serves as somebody's permanent residence and they are unable to secure safe alternative housing. The campground closure also excludes fixed structures that serve as place of residence for a single family when no other viable place of residence exists.*
- *Outdoor activities such as fishing can continue, but people should observe proper social distancing and not congregate together.*
- *State parks are able to stay open at this time, but ODNR has the right to take whatever action necessary to enforce social distancing if they feel people are not being safe or are gathering in parks.*

*The order is now in effect and will last until May 1, 2020, but will be reassessed as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to develop. The full order can be found at [ottawahealth.org](http://ottawahealth.org).*

***The order can be enforced by the local health departments and local law enforcement.***
